Darcy

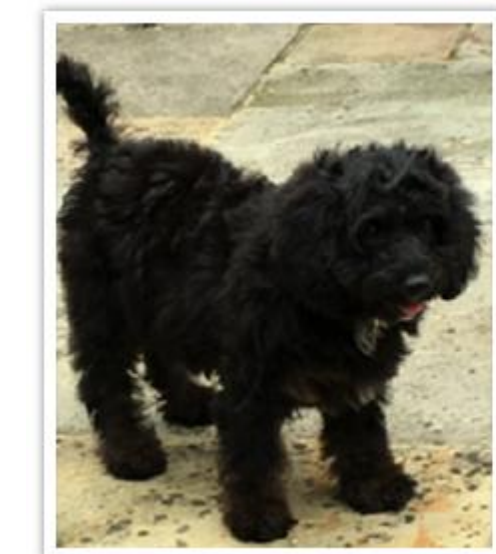
Darcy is a lovely sociable dog who loves the beach as well as meeting other dogs.

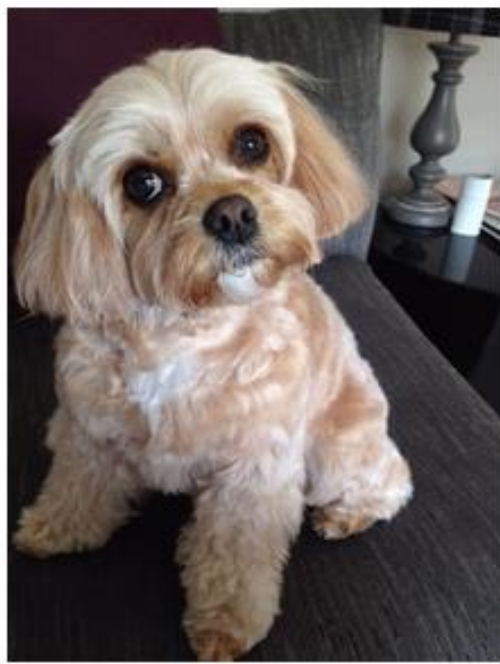
Scooby
