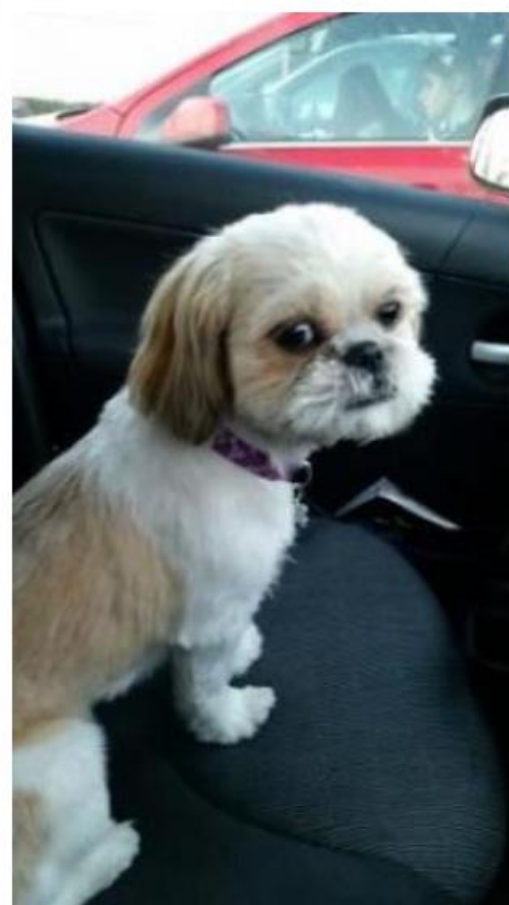


## Lady

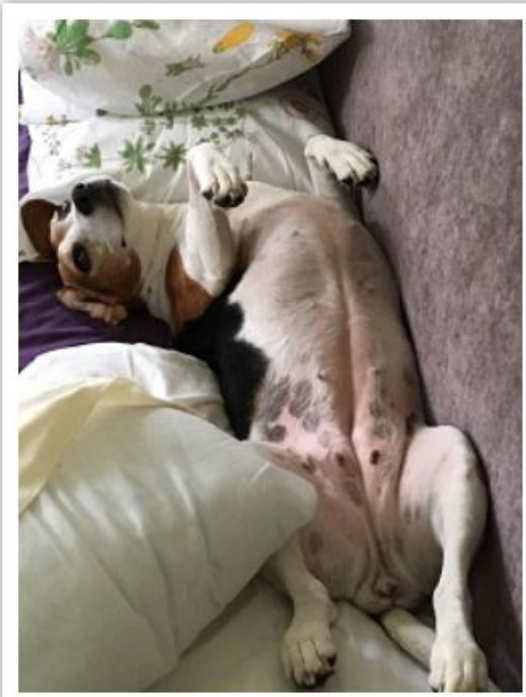
Chino loves anywhere he can run off lead and play with other dogs.

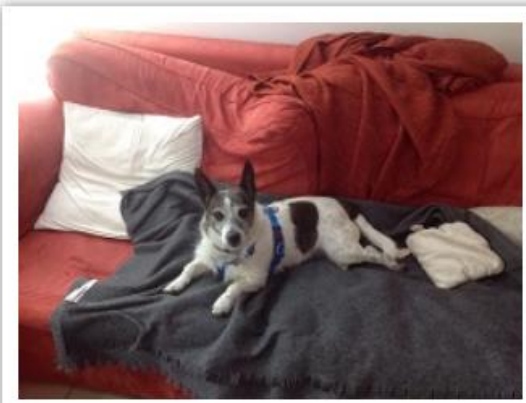
Now back in Dorset, Zippy enjoys a walk at Hamworthy Park and [Upton Country Park](#).
